Such as someone who has died, for good health, or in thanksgiving for graces received, these are listed in the weekly Mass Sheet and are usually announced at the beginning of the Mass. To book Masses, please use one of the envelopes available in the porch or any envelopes. Write the intention on it with date requested and your contact details if you want the mass confirmed and enclose the donation. Hand the intention to Father Paul or post through the Presbytery door, or put in the Sacristy. currently We have lots of dates free for your Mass intentions.

Counters needed We are in need of some new counters to join the counting rota. The role involves cash counting on a Monday of that past weekend's collections for Saturday & Sunday, it takes roughly 45 mins and is very simple and no computer skills are needed.
