The Archbishop's Certificate The Agency for Evangelisation and Catechesis is pleased to announce the launch of the Archbishop's Certificate to support not just the work of catechesis and of evangelisation and formation in our diocese. The Archbishop's Certificate is an online, systematic course over 2 years with attendance at three study days (on Saturdays) at the Amigo Hall, St George's Cathedral, in Southwark. The study days combine a balance of teaching, liturgy, social time and prayer. Students are supported with 9 online study sessions throughout the course. The certificate is open to all who work towards this in our diocese whether in parishes, chaplaincy work, schools and in their families. We encourage those who volunteer in a parish to speak to their Parish Priest about participation on the Archbishop's Certificate. 
