Confirmation 2024 The list has now closed. Unfortunately, due to the extensive damage of the parish hall we will not be able to run the program till this is repaired which may not be till the autumn. The classes will be held after the 10am Mass till 1pm. The catechists will be preparing a program not just for the confirmation candidates but also for the parents who will be expected to attend.

We will be asking parents of the children to be confirmed to attend some evangelisation sessions too.

<u>Lent Appeal/Collection</u> The Lent Charity this year will be in aid of **KCAH** Kingston Churches Action on Homeless. Based at St Peter's Church, Norbiton, KCAH run a winter Night Shelter (until the end of March) as well as support services for single people in housing crisis in Kingston.
