Lenten Appeal: For the construction of a wall fence for a Health Unit. As I mentioned last week proposing a Lenten Appeal for those who are able to donate and support a project. Back in Uganda, my home parish runs a maternity clinic with admissions and the parish would like to construct a wall fence for security. This facility and unit was built by the parishioners as the Church does so, with support and provision of health, education and other services. They would like to build a perimeter fence to provide some security and convenience to the mothers admitted in the facility.
