Lent Appeal/Collection The Lent Charity this year will be in aid of **KCAH** Kingston
Churches Action on Homeless. Based at St Peter's Church, Norbiton, KCAH run a winter
Night Shelter (until the end of March) as well as support services for single people in
housing crisis in Kingston. KCAH aim is to help them secure a safe and stable home and to
help them start rebuilding their lives. Let's support our local homeless people living on
streets near us. This charity shows local churches of different faiths work together with one
goal. Cheques can be made out to KCAH. We raised £352.37 so far.

Poor Parishes Next week's 2nd collection 17th march will be for Poor Parishes of the Diocese. This
enables the Archbishop to make grants to some of the poorer parishes in the diocese.
