Write the intention on it with date requested and your contact details if you want the mass confirmed and enclose the donation. Hand the intention to Father Paul or post through the Presbytery door, or put in the Sacristy. **currently We have lots of dates free for your Mass intentions.**

<u>Prisoner Sunday</u> Next Sunday 8th October is Prisoner Sunday and the 2nd collection will be for PACT. To support prisoners and their families.

This goes in its entirety to support churches, hospital, schools and vocation in countries where the Church is new, young or poor. The money goes directly to Bishops in the mission territories.
